



LETTER OF INTENT

between

Griffith University, Queensland, Australia

and

Suzuka University of Medical Science, Mie Prefecture, Japan

Individually a party and collectively parties to this Letter of Intent:

- 1. The parties believe that mutual benefit can be derived from scholarly interaction and cultural interchange.
- 2. The parties regard the following areas of cooperation as desirable and feasible:
 - Short-term study tours to Griffith English Language Institute (GELI)
 - Opportunities for other forms of co-operation, such as the delivery of award and nonaward courses
- 3. The terms of specific areas of cooperation will be further considered and agreed upon in writing by the parties prior to the initiation of any activity.
- 4. The parties agree that this Letter of Intent is not a formal legal agreement giving rise to any legal relationship, rights, duties or consequences, but it is only a definite expression and record of the purpose of the parties to which the parties are bound in honour only.
- 5. This Letter of Intent will commence on the date it is signed by both parties and remain in force for a period of three (3) years unless terminated earlier. Either party may terminate this agreement by giving six months' notice to the other party. The Letter of Intent may be amended at any time by the mutual consent of the co-operating institutions.
- 6. The application of digital signatures and delivery by electronic transmission in portable document format (PDF) of this executed agreement is as effective as delivery of an originally executed agreement.
